### **Overview**

Operating System, Data and Application Restoration ensures that operations will be restored to where they were at the time of the last successful back-up before a hardware failure.

### **Features and Benefits**

- Faster return to full operation
- Controlled costs
- Coordination between hardware and software support organization
- A field engineer will restore the operating system and data to where they were at the time of the last successful back-up prior to hardware failure.
- Includes initialization of hard disks, reinstallation of operating system, and restoration of backed-up data.
- Operating System, Data and Applications Restoration maintains the status quo of a properly installed system.

### **Eligibility**

- Operating System, Data and Applications Restoration is available in conjunction with a Maintenance Agreement.
- You must have followed an approved back-up procedure, and maintained

the operating system at a current revision level.

- The hardware configuration must include an appropriate back-up medium.
- There must also be a key operator who has been trained in system administration fundamentals.
- We require access to equipment, software media, back-up media, manuals, passwords, equipment keys, and other essential material.

### **Pricing**

Pricing depends on the operating system, the capacity of the hard drives, and the applications and database.

### **Limitations**

Does not cover:

- data that was not backed-up;
- back-up procedures, applications packages, operating systems upgrades, reconfiguration or enhancement of operating systems except as required to recover from a catastrophic hardware or software failure;
- hardware not covered by a Maintenance Agreement.
